

5 feet of a driveway, no parking within 15 feet of a fire hydrant, no parking on sidewalks, no parking within 20 feet of a crosswalk.

The city of Olympia requires that vehicles parked on city streets must be moved at least every three days. Because parking is so scarce, the community cannot afford to allow any street parking to become long term vehicle storage.

### **Zero Scaping 2019**

The new zero scape project was accomplished under the direction of Scott Thalhamer and several other volunteers. It is designed to be low maintenance and save us money on irrigation expenses. We applied for and received approval for a grant from the city of Olympia to do the work.



### **Tent Caterpillars**

We had an infestation of tent caterpillars in some of the trees on Crestwood Place this summer. The worst thing about tent caterpillars are the tents themselves. These ugly blemishes can ruin a great view of a forest and make the trees in your yard look like they're infested. Even worse, these tents hold the leaf-killing caterpillars that

devastate your trees and shrubs. Our landscapers removed the tents and sprayed the affected area with bacillus thuringiensis which kills the caterpillars.

### **Bulletin Board**

The plexiglass on our bulletin board had several cracks and was marred by tape used to post notices on the outside. We took it to a local shop for repairs and it came back good as new

### **Walking Lane**

We heard the suggestion of creating a walking lane down the fire lane for pedestrians, especially children walking to and from school from a homeowner. We painted a yellow line designating a walking path to make the lane a little safer for pedestrians. Simple enough solution to raise driver awareness



### **Compliance Reminders**

**Abandoned Vehicles:** We have been somewhat successful in removing abandoned vehicles stored on our streets. We work with code enforcement at the city to get them towed

**Dog Poop:** Please pick up the poop! When walking your dog, carry a plastic bag for cleanup and make sure it is on a leash. We have 3 dog waste stations that have poop bags in the neighborhood.

**Garbage Pickup:** Garbage pickup is Thursday morning. Pickup alternates between recyclables and trash. Organics (compost and yard waste, grass clippings, etc.) are picked up the Monday the week recyclables are picked up.
