It is that time again. We've hit this in previous years, but there are always new people and those who have misplaced the instruction. For several of us in the neighborhood, we have discovered that, periodically, the furnace will stop working. You will hear it click on and click off, but it will not blow warm air. If it does blow warm air it will only be for a couple of minutes, not long enough to warm the house. The problem is that there is a clog in the vacuum line that causes the heater to go on and off. The clog is due to the additive that they put into natural gas to give it an odor. When the gas burns the additive is reduced to dust residue that remains in your heater. Eventually it builds up in the vacuum line and blocks it. It is easy to fix.

At the bottom is a highlighted area showing the hose that you need to deal with. The clog occurs where the B is.

The easiest way to get rid of it is pull it off at the A and blow hard through it until you feel the clog give way. It will be a noticeable increase in air flow. If it is really clogged, you might need to use something stronger to break it loose like some stiff wire or a long needle. When the clog is cleared up you should be able to blow through the hose.

Then just put the hose back on at A (no clamps needed) and it should clear it up.
